## **Final dance show information**

Our technical runs and dress runs will happen on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> January and Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> January. Students will be in the main school hall not the drama studio from 10.30am until 5pm both days. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and lots of drinks with them as once they arrive at school they will not be able to go into the village but will remain in school at all times. Students will need to bring their costumes with them on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> January as this is when we will be doing the dress rehearsal. Students should bring their dancewear on both days and lots of warm clothing so that they can keep their muscles warm. Students need to be picked up from the front car park on both days.

On Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February the Primary schools will be coming into school to watch the dress rehearsals for the dance show. Students will be in lessons for 1a 1b so will need to be in school uniform. They will then all meet in the school hall at the end of break at 11.10.

The show for the primary schools will start at 1pm so students in the show will need to bring a packed lunch this day, so that they will have time to eat before the show.

They will need to bring their costumes and some warm clothes such as a sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms. Students will then remain in school at 3.20pm until the first evening show at 7pm. They will need to bring a packed tea with them and ensure that they have ample drinks for the evening. They will be able to leave their costumes in their changing rooms for the following day.

On Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> February students will need to be in school at 10.30am when the whole cast will meet in the hall. The matinee is at 2pm and students will then all remain in school until the evening performance starts at 7pm. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and a packed tea with them.

We will have a clearer idea of the running time for the show after the technical runs on the 29<sup>th</sup> January, however, the approximate time for picking students up on the Friday night is 9.30pm. The approximate pick up time for Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> February is 9.45pm as students will need to ensure that their changing rooms are emptied and that they have all of their belongings with them.

We look forward to seeing you at the shows to see how amazing the students are and how hard they have worked.
