Dear Parents/Carers,

We have 30 places for an industry day at The Junction in Cambridge on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Industry Days give young people and opportunity to develop insight and knowledge from those that work in the field, connecting the future creative workforce with industry professionals.

Four times a year Cambridge Junction throws open its doors to young people who would like a career in the creative and cultural sector. Held in conjunction with Creative and Cultural Skills, The Junction Creative Choices Industry Days provide insight into the wide range of job opportunities in the arts and exposure to what happens behind the scenes. Young people are able to participate in a meet-the-staff round-table question and answer session about entry routes, career paths and individual experiences and to participate in 'behind-the-scenes' workshops in areas such as technical theatre, design and directing. Young people also get to take part in a tour of Cambridge Junction.

Students will leave school at 8.55am and travel by coach to The Junction. They will not need to wear to school uniform for this trip and will need bring a packed lunch and a small amount of spending money if they so wish.

The day ends at 3.30pm and we will travel back by coach to BVC arriving at approximately 4.15 pm. Students will need to be picked up from the back carpark.

The trip is open to anyone in Year 9, 10 or 11 next academic year who has an interest in careers in creative arts, however, it is not a part of their GCSE course so it is not essential that they attend.
