CURRICULUM DELIVERY	Students work through a scheme of learning which flows through Years 7 and 8 which develops the skills necessary to be successful if they choose to study Art at GCSE. Within the scheme of learning specific activities are set which help the students to progress steadily with technical language, skills and understanding whilst being able to explore the creative and therapeutic qualities of the subject.			
CURRICULUM AIMS	Year 7 is very much a year for laying down foundations of the KS3 Art curriculum. Students learn what is expected when using their Art sketchbook. They also work sequentially through a project, from research, to planning and on to the making of a final image. The "elements" of Art are explored in practical work and they begin to research and analyses the work of artists, chosen to support their practical studies. In addition, to the topics mentioned below, other opportunities may arise throughout the school year, through competitions, clubs and curriculum days.
