


# Science

For our Year 7 students they have been looking at the rate of dissolving types of sugar, to the effect of surface area on dissolving time using jelly. Our Year 8s have been investigating the effectiveness of different indigestion tablets on neutralising stomach acid. Year 10s took part in an eye dissection and our Year 11s undertook a heart dissection to learn about the structure and function of the heart.
