As we enter a new term it is worth recapping our process on how to contact or speak to a member of staff, if you ever wish to do so. We do ask you do this via email. A full staff list, along with email addresses are available on our website here¹. We do ask that you allow staff 48 hours to respond, unless it is a safeguarding concern which we ask you highlight to us straight away to take immediate action. If the staff member does not come back to you within 2 days, please do contact the office as it may well be they are off school and then the office can pass the question onto a different member of staff in their absence. Can I also take a moment to remind parents on our expectations regarding uniform. Students are to be wearing plain black shoes every day, not trainers please. Trainers should only be worn when in PE lessons as part of their PE kit. We also expect students to be wearing a blazer at all times while in school, except when explicit instruction has been given to remove these by the class teacher, in hospitality or technology lessons for example. Students are permitted to wear a plain black jumper, however this must be underneath the blazer and not worn instead of. We continue to receive donations of uniform which can be purchased second hand through our PFA.

As we look to next week, our Year 8s have two days of core exams which will support them in building resilience to exam conditions, starting on Monday. We are also holding our Year 9 parents' evenings which will be run online across 3 days - Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

A separate communication has been sent out regarding the Teacher Strike days currently planned on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May. If you have not received this, please let us know. As a reminder, we are expecting all year 11 students in school on both days unless they have a medical appointment or are unwell. Unless your child has been specifically invited into school, students in years 7-10 should remain at home and access work set on Google Classrooms.
